Players are expected to pay for all individual costs incurred. (Approximately \$1500.00)

All Players nominating must attend each trial. A written submission or medical certificate is required if the trial is missed. Players must trial in their age groups and will generally be required to play in their own age groups, however players may be considered to play in younger or older age groups at the sole discretion of the selectors, and with the player’s consent.

Team members will be expected to attend weekly training sessions (generally on Sunday Mornings)
