- Who:** The course is aimed at those wishing to obtain Hockey Victoria/Hockey Australia umpire accreditation. However the session is suitable for all standards, so those keen to learn more about hockey umpiring are more than welcome. (Players, Parents and Spectators).
- When:** 18th June 2010 & 19th June 2010 (You only need to attend one)
- Times:** Friday night 6:30pm to 8pm.
Saturday night 6:30pm to 8pm.
- Facilitator:** Tom Swaby & Dennis Martin.
- Where:** Hockey Albury/Wodonga Club House.
- Cost:** There is no cost for attending the seminar, but please note that there is a Hockey Australia registration fee of \$50 should you choose to be accredited as a Beginner Umpire.

REGISTRATION GUIDE

The Beginner Umpire Training Program is designed to train umpires in the fundamental concepts of umpiring including fitness, positioning, signals and ensuring the safety and enjoyment of players.

The program is directed towards parents, players and umpires who are involved in umpiring beginner level club hockey.

The Beginner Umpire training program can be accessed as an educational resource for currently accredited individuals, as well as being a training requirement for those wishing to obtain their Beginner Umpire Accreditation.

HOW TO REGISTER GUIDE

In order to complete your Beginner umpire accreditation you must complete the following:

1. Register on-line with Hockey Australia – Hockey Ed (\$50)
2. Complete the on-line quiz or **attend a HV Beginner Umpire Training program**
3. Achieve competency in a practical evaluation (assessment)

The Umpire Training Program structure is focused on delivering programs with quality presenters/assessors, resources and ongoing professional development. These training programs will be conducted in each of Hockey Victoria's 10 zones and will see a shift in the focus towards developing practical officiating skills and self-development and therefore better trained officials to meet the demands of the game.

To participate in the Umpire Training program you must register in two places –

To gain a Beginner Umpire accreditation you must be able to demonstrate the required competencies.

In most cases the level of game to achieve these competencies will be a minimum of Junior- Under 15A, 17A, Senior- Pennant D.
