Conditions of Entry

1. The carnival will be under the sole control of the Carnival Committee.
2. There shall be a final match to determine the winner of each division.
3. The Carnival Committee reserves the right to cancel any division if there are insufficient teams entered to form a satisfactory draw.
4. The Carnival Committee reserves the right to re-grade any team or combine divisions at its' discretion.
5. The Carnival will commence with a March Past of all competing teams.
6. All competing teams shall provide umpires when requested by the Carnival Committee.
7. Teams shall forfeit their deposit if;
 - a) The team fails to take part in the March Past
 - b) The team forfeits any scheduled match
 - c) The team fails to supply umpires for games that they were rostered
 - d) Found guilty of any misconduct on the field or bringing the game of Hockey into disrepute in and around the Albury-Wodonga region.
 - e) The team withdraws from the Carnival after the closing date for entries
8. Entries will only be accepted when accompanied by the full entry fee plus the security deposit.
9. Late entries will only be accepted at the discretion of the Carnival Committee.
10. Mixed teams shall have a maximum of five male players (including goalkeepers) on the field at any one time.
11. In all other matters the decision of the Carnival Committee shall be final.
12. Participants in the carnival are to provide their own player accident insurance.
