



Code of Conduct
Guidelines for Behaviour
Representative Players / Umpires

CONGRATULATIONS, you have been selected to represent your Association. Team Management are responsible for you whilst representing Hockey Albury-Wodonga Inc.

THE FOLLOWING GUIDELINES ARE BY ORDER OF THE REPRESENTATIVE POLICY COMMITTEE AND THE BOARD OF MANAGEMENT OF HOCKEY ALBURY-WODONGA INC.

Travel and Accommodation

Team/s are to travel together to all matches/championships unless specific permission has been received from team management.

Players are expected to stay with the team and must remain at their place of accommodation unless approval has been received from team management.

All players and officials must abide by the rules and regulations of the carrier, motelier and team management at all times.

Dress

All players must wear a Hockey Albury-Wodonga (HAW) representative jacket when playing for or representing the association.

Where supplied, full tracksuit and accessories must be worn at all times, including travelling to and from matches and at all official team functions or as directed by team management.

Drugs, Alcohol and Smoking

HAW will not tolerate the use of any illegal substance at any time.

There will be no consumption of alcohol by any persons under the age of 18 years.

There will be no smoking for players under the age of 18 without written permission from the parents. The permission note is to be signed by the parent / guardian in the presence of an official of HAW. Smoking will only be allowed in designated areas.

On Field Conduct

Representatives are reminded that no bad language, abuse, dissent or unsportsmanlike conduct will be tolerated toward officials, spectators, umpires, opposing teams or team mates (this includes equipment abuse).

Off Field Conduct

Whilst you are representing and/or wearing your representative uniform, it is your responsibility to present yourself, your team, and your association in a most commendable way at all times.

Finance

All representative players must be a financial member of their chosen club and HAW.

Training / Meetings / Functions

It is expected that all selected players attend all training sessions, meetings and functions unless notified to, and cleared by, team management.

Sponsor Obligation

Representatives must agree to support all sponsors by wearing designated uniform prior to, during and after representative matches, at functions, during promotional work and when requested to do so by the team management.

Vandalism

This is the direct responsibility of the offender and will not be tolerated. If under the age of 18 years, parents will be notified as well as the appropriate authorities in all cases without exception.

General

1. Respect the rights, dignity and worth of fellow players, coaches, officials and spectators.
2. HAW do not tolerate acts of aggression.
3. Respect the talent, potential and development of fellow players and competitors.
4. Care for and respect the equipment provided to you as part of your program.
5. Be frank and honest with your coach concerning illness and injury and your ability to train fully within the program requirements.
6. Conduct yourself in a professional manner at all times i.e. language, temper, punctuality.
7. Maintain high personal behaviour standards at all times.
8. Abide by the rules and respect the decision of the official, making all appeals through the formal process and respecting the final decision.
9. Be honest in your attitude and preparation to training. Work equally hard for yourself and your team.
10. Cooperate with coaches and staff in development of programs to adequately prepare you for competition at the highest level.

Discipline / Penalties

Team Management and the Board of Management HAW reserve the right to recommend further investigation and / or discipline all representative players to the extent that they can be excluded from representing the association.

The breach of any of the above rules may result in one of either of the following:

- Immediate suspension from team
- Exclusion from further representation with HAW
- Payment for any damage caused.
- Being sent home at own cost.
